

MISSISSIPPI STUD

Mississippi's players compete against a pay table rather than the dealer, and win if their hand is a pair of Jacks or better. Players make an Ante Wager and receive two cards that will be combined with three community cards to create a five-card poker hand.

The dealer will place three community cards face down in the middle of the layout. After the players receive their first two cards, they may either fold or make a 3rd Street bet of one, two, or three times their Ante. The dealer reveals the first community card and players may either fold or make the 4th Street bet of one, two, or three times their Ante. The dealer then reveals the second community card and players may either fold or make the 5th Street bet of one, two, or three times their Ante.

After the dealer turns over the final community card, he resolves all bets left in action. Players win if their five-card hand contains a pair of Jacks or better.

Note: When a player folds, he forfeits all bets left in action.

HAND	PAYS
Royal Flush	500 to 1
Straight Flush	100 to 1
Four of a Kind	40 to 1
Full House	10 to 1
Flush	6 to 1
Straight	4 to 1
Three of a Kind	3 to 1
Two Pair	2 to 1
Pair of Jacks or Better	1 to 1
Pair of 6's through 10's	PUSH

THREE CARD BONUS WAGER

Players may place an optional Three Card Bonus Wager using the three community cards. The wager is an independent wager paid in accordance with the following pay table:

HAND TYPE	PAY OUT ODDS
STRAIGHT FLUSH	40 to 1
THREE-OF-A-KIND	30 to 1
STRAIGHT	6 to 1
FLUSH	3 to 1
PAIR	1 to 1

PROGRESSIVE JACKPOT

A player may choose to play the optional Progressive Jackpot wager by placing \$5 on the bet. All progressive pays are based on five card poker hands. Rules and pay tables for the game available on table signage.

HAND TYPE	PAYS	ENVY
ROYAL FLUSH	100%	1,000 for 1
STRAIGHT FLUSH	10%	300 for 1
FOUR-OF-A-KIND	300 for 1	N/A
FULL HOUSE	50 for 1	N/A
FLUSH	40 for 1	N/A
STRAIGHT	30 for 1	N/A
THREE-OF-A-KIND	9 for 1	N/A

The aggregate payout per player is \$50,000, not including the progressive jackpot
