- A single ante will be paid from the big blind for the entire table. The big blind is paid before the ante.
- Management reserves the right to alter, change, or cancel this tournament.
- Management will not be held responsible in the event of typographical errors or misinformation on the website or printed material about this event, and players will have no claim in these matters.
- The Tournament Director's decisions are final.
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution.
- Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without a refund.
- It's every player's responsibility to bring unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities to management.
- Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.
- Tournament tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Payouts will be approximately 12.5% of the field.
- Players may chop only when at the final table and in the money. Once a chop has been proposed and a player declines, no further discussion of a chop may be brought up until a player is eliminated.
- \$96 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$34 is a registration fee of which \$11 will go towards staffing and \$3 will go towards the promotional fund.
